SPIRITED MISS, off a step slowly, raced in midpack, closed two-wide late turn, rallied smartly, got up late and well in hand. KIAMA led early, was joined nearing the turn, dueled, shook clear upper stretch but failed to contain the winner in the late stages. KISS IN THE FOREST dueled on the turn, yielded upper stretch but chased to the wire. PULPATION stalked the pace, came two and three-wide through the turn and finished all out. ALMIRA FAWN stalked the pace, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then flattened out in the late stages. EASTERN ATLANTIC stalked the pace, quickened late turn, chased into the stretch then tired in the final 16th. LUNA LUNA, off slowly, settled off the pace, saved ground but never reached contention. ENGLISH SUNRISE raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn but never reached contention. ASIAN ODYSSEY, squeezed back at the start, raced in midpack, came five-wide through the turn then lacked a rally. ENDLESSPOSSIBILITY, off slowly, trailed throughout.
