NOT TOO TACKY settled on the outside, bid five wide on the turn for home then rallied best in the run to the wire. KILLDARES PROSPECT off the pace, was wide and coming on into the stretch then finished it off with a good stretch rally. JOEY'S BEST had a wide trip and was outside foes and four wide on the far turn then weakened in the run to the wire. KING OF THE SWAMP vied between foes and was in the heat of the battle turning for home then gave way. PEACE BAY pressed the pace while between foes and was a factor into the stretch then weakened. PIRATE'S LEGEND in touch inside and in striking position turning for into the stretch, lacked the needed kick. ABRUPTLY had inside speed, dueled on the far turn from the rail then faltered. HUMBER VALLEY was off the pace and had no serious bid. T. T.'S POINT was outside of foes and off the early pace, never threatened and was not a stretch contender. HAT TRICK KID was off the pace and not a factor. HISAKI trailed and showed little.
