ON RAINBOW BRIDGE raced in midpack early, closed and bid three-wide late turn, was engaged and dueled through the stretch, drifted out under left-handed urging and prevailed under a drive. LEXIE LOU settled off the pace, closed four-wide and bid late turn, dueled and was forced out through the stretch while under steady right handed encouragement and was outfinished. PALADIN BAY raced in midpack, was hustled three-wide late turn and finished all out. TWO BREWS TO GO settled in midpack, closed four-wide late turn and finished under a determined stretch drive. EYES HER MAN forced the pace, dropped back late backstretch and was under strong restraint early turn, settled, then rallied mildly. SKYLANDER GIRL pulled hard along the rail on the backstretch, settled midturn then flattened out with a 16th to run. SEEKING A GLITTER stalked the pace, chased between foes on the turn then lacked a closing response. MAKING IT HAPPEN led early, shook clear midway of the backstretch, was joined late turn, gave way and tired in the stretch. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER ON LEXIE LOU AGAINST ON RAINBOW BRIDGE FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SECOND.
