SKYBOUND was reserved off the lead in the 5 path, came even 4 wide in the final turn, drew clear in late stretch under intermittent urging. KIRIDASHI was well rated 3 wide, vied for lead into the far turn, assumed command briefly at the 3/8 pole but could not stay with the winner, held place to be second best. WILD JAZZ was unhurried early, saved ground into the far turn, angled out upper stretch and finished with a late gain. CRACKER'S FOLLY was void of early speed between horses, finished with a late rally in the three path. SEISMIC REPORT was allowed to settle inside, found his best stride late between horses. RANDY REGENT was hustled along from the inside to force the pace early, dropped back upper stretch. INCITATUS (BAR) unhurried early, was 3 wide around turn but lacked a late response. ALEA IACTA EST was hustled along to vie for lead between horses, tired in the stretch.
