LEWINSKY was taken back in the early going and moved to the rail, saved ground through the turn, rallied along the rail in the stretch and got up in the final strides under a drive. PLENTY O' WOMAN was hustled along setting a pressured pace, opened a clear lead around the turn, held the advantage to deep stretch but gave way in the final strides and just held place. CHAMPAGNE SWEEP was unhurried early between horses, angled out in upper stretch and closed with a rush. ANDOVER SWEEP stalked the early pace outside of rivals, loomed boldly in upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. GINGER GERRY was void of early speed off the rail, swung wide at the 3/8 pole and finished with a mild rally outside of rivals. VIXEN STAR was hustled along pressing the early pace along the rail, moved off the rail for the drive but tired. MARI ASCOT settled in the middle of the pack along the rail, was blocked in the drive then shyed from the whip in deep stretch and dropped back. AMAZONIAN STRIKER was unhurried early and lacked a late response. TWIST MY HEART was hustled along pressing the early pace 3 wide then faded in the stretch.
