DREAM ABOUT set a pressured pace three wide, was headed briefly late in the backstretch, drew clear on the turn, and continued to draw off to the wire as much the best. MUTUAL AFFAIR chased three wide, took the place position inside in the stretch. FINNERTY'S FROLIC came through inside to gain the lead briefly late in the backstretch, was outfinished from the place position off the rail in the stretch. CAN IHAVETHISDANCE chased four wide early, dropped back, came again in the stretch. BYE BYE ALI chased from off the rail, faltered on the turn. EXPLOSIVE AFFAIR chased four wide, weakened on the turn. NINE CARATS was off the rail, and not a threat. GLENNASCAUL raced three wide, and was not a factor. PENNY SIXPENGE trailed wide, passed a tired one. PASSAGE ROAD raced inside, showed little.
