Footnotes

HANDY HAROLD showed brief speed then settled and stalked the pace, bid along the rail near the 1/4 pole, was clear at the top of the stretch and held sway under a drive. FLIP FOR THE COIN also showed brief speed, stalked the pace, angled from the second path to four-wide on the far turn then finished determinedly. FULL OF WISDOM raced midpack, closed angling from two-wide to five-wide on the far turn and rallied gamely. PIRATE'S LEGEND moved clear on the first turn, set a reserved pace, was headed late on the far turn, chased into the stretch and tired in the late stages. DIPLOMATIC IMPACT raced midpack early, was hustled three-wide from well back on the far turn but did not threaten. CIANORTE, well back early, raced three and four-wide on the far turn but never reached contention. T. T.'S POINT settled off the pace, saved ground, was hustled on the far turn but tired in the stretch.
