PURE ATTITUDE stalked the pace, chased late turn, caught the leader just into the final furlong and prevailed under a drive. OMAGGIO set a reserved pace, was collared in the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. GONE TRAJECTORY raced midpack, was hustled four-wide late turn and finished under a determined drive. CATCH THE LUCK, rated midpack, chased late turn then evened out in the stretch. AWESOME RHYTHM raced midpack four-wide and never reached contention. EL GRAN BRETT, off a step slowly, raced off the pace, was roused late turn but showed no response. TORQUAY, rated well off the pace, trailed the field then lacked a rally.
