Weight Three-Year-Olds 122 lbs.; Older 126 lbs.; Non-winners of a Grade I race in 2010, allowed 3 lbs.; Of a Grade II race in 2010 or a Grade I race in 2009, allowed 5 lbs.; Of a Grade III race in 2010 or a Grade II race in 2009, allowed 7 lbs.; Of a Sweepstakes of \$60,000 in 2010 or a Grade III race in 2009, allowed 9 lbs. (No Canadian Bred Allowance.) (Note: Grades as recognized by the International Cataloguing Standards Committee.) Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. Closed with 25 nominations. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry, by a non-refundable fee of \$4,000, which includes the entry fee. *Plus up to \$24,300 Ontario Sired/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. Footnotes

SMOKEY FIRE pressed the pace on the backstretch, stalked three-wide on the turn, launched an all out stretch drive and got up late. JUNGLE WAVE stalked the early pace then moved between rivals to force the issue on the turn, challenged in earnest upper stretch, duelled and bested his rival leading for a few strides late but was caught in deep stretch. FATAL BULLET led quickly and was taken in hand, set a pressured pace, was engaged upper stretch, duelled, then gave way grudgingly in the late stages. PORTER'S GATE, rated off the pace, was roused three-wide late turn but failed to menace. SIGNATURE RED raced midpack between rivals, was hustled from early turn then evened out in the stretch. SOUTHDALÉ raced midpack four-wide, was roused late turn but lacked a serious response. FIELD COMMISSION rated off the pace along the rail, was taken back further at the turn then lacked a rally.
