MARK'S SOUL raced in midpack, was hustled five-wide late turn, bid in deep stretch and prevailed, driving. WHERE IS'EM broke in the air, stalked the pace

in hand, chased four-wide into the stretch, gained a short lead in the final furlong but was headed and gave way grudgingly. VICAR STREET, in touch, chased five-wide late turn then finished gamely between foes. EMPIRE RISING raced in midpack, chased on the far turn then rallied between rivals. FIRST RATE stalked early then forced the pace on the backstretch, took a narrow lead entering the turn, led briefly in the stretch and gave way. RINK RAT raced off the pace, chased angling three to five-wide on the far turn then finished gamely while widest. GOTTA BE SMOOTH raced off the pace, was hustled late backstretch and turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch but never reached contention. CUVARA raced off the pace, chased on the far turn but evened out in the late stages. TRAJECTORY'S DREAM stalked the pace, dropped back along the rail on the far turn then showed a mild rally in the stretch. JOEY'S BEST settled in midpack, chased three-wide on the far turn but lacked a closing response. PISCITELLI set a pressured pace, was headed at the far turn, chased hard along the rail and rebid at the top of the stretch, dueled, then tired a furlong out. MARCELLINO raced off the pace, was hustled on the far turn, launched an all stretch drive but tired in the late stages.
