Footnotes

ASCOT MATT showed early speed, vied briefly and was pulled to a lead early backstretch, entertained a challenge at the far turn, dueled to the final furlong and drove clear. EMPIRE RISING raced midpack, chased late turn, came five-wide to the top of the stretch and rallied gamely. PERSONAL SIGNAL, well back early, closed into the turn, chased to the stretch and finished determinedly. HOLY SCHNEIKIES, in range, closed along the rail late backstretch, bid into the turn, dueled but yielded in the final furlong. LOUIE MONDELLO showed early speed, was taken back early from a duel early backstretch, stalked to the turn, chased to the stretch then flattened out. TEQUILA MAX settled off the pace, was hustled into the stretch but never reached contention. GALLIPOLI raced midpack, came three and four-wide through the turn, chased from the top of the stretch but tired in the final furlong. AIR HORIZON raced midpack, was hustled late turn then lacked a stretch response. FOUND SOME GOLD, always well back, trailed the field and was eased upper stretch.
