Footnotes

ALACHUA raced midpack, closed four-wide late turn, bid 3/16th out and drove clear. CAMPFIRE GIRL settled off the pace, raced three and four-wide on the turn then rallied between rivals through the stretch. MISS OLIE raced off the pace, was two and three-wide on the turn, was blocked upper stretch until the 3/16th pole then rallied late between horses. ART PRINCESS raced midpack between horses, came five-wide into the stretch and chased under an all out drive. VALEISHA raced on the fringes, came three-wide through the turn, was all out in the stretch but evened out late. DANCIGER raced off the pace, came five-wide through the turn, was hustled in the stretch but evened out in the final furlong. DELI LAMA, off a step slowly, saved ground then was unable to threaten late with a run between rivals. ALTA LAKE raced off the pace, was hustled five-wide into the stretch then lacked a strong late response. EMERALD BEECH, on the fringes along the second path, cut to the rail at the top of the stretch then evened out. SOUPER SWEET led early, was headed and stalked through the turn, bid 3/16th out but was outkicked but the winner and tired. JOVIAL JILL raced midpack two-wide, closed into the stretch and flattened out. BLONDE HUMOR took a clear lead into the turn, set the pace to upper stretch and tired.
