FOR THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLES. By subscription of \$150 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$1,500 when making entry. The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight 123 lbs. LADY SHAKESPEARE raced off the pace, closed with the tightly knit field late turn, responded five-wide upper stretch, reached the fore in the final furlong and was clear in the final sixteenth under a drive. CAREM CRESCENT, in range, closed five-wide into the stretch, took command 3/16th out but failed to stave off the winner. FOREST UPROAR raced off the pace, angled from four-wide to six-wide on the turn, launched her bid upper stretch but could not match strides and evened out late. COSMIC QUEEN raced off the pace, saved ground, was blocked at the top of the stretch, angled out, finished determinedly and gained steadily in the late stages. SAUCEY EVENING raced midpack between rivals, was in range at the top of the stretch but was

blocked then came up empty when clear. HOOH WHY raced off the pace along the rail, was boxed in late turn then evened out when clear in the stretch. MOMMIE WHIZ, in range, was in tight quarters at the top of the stretch, failed with a bid midstretch and flattened out. C KARMA broke alertly, stalked the pace, chased into the stretch, challenged upper stretch but was passed and tired. AILBE forced the pace, took a short lead late turn, was engaged upper stretch and tired 3/16th out. RING BLING raced off the pace, saved ground but lacked a rally. ALAMANDA DRIVE set a pressured pace, was headed late turn and tired at the top of the stretch.
