DEPUTY CURES BLUES was allowed to settle in the three path, continued off the rail on the turn and roused entering the stretch, assumed command in the drive and drew clear. SENSUOUS CINNAMON dueled for the early lead inside of rivals, battled gamely in the drive and held place. CEREMONIAL was allowed to settle outside of rivals, came four wide in the drive and rallied belatedly. WHATS YOUR GAME was allowed to settle outside of rivals, roused four wide on the turn, but never rallied and was never a threat. PERSNICKITY GAL dueled outside of rivals, then weakened in the stretch and dropped back. HAZOR was void of early speed inside of rivals, saved ground on the turn and lacked a late response. UNDER THE ELMS raced close up in the two path, then dropped back in the stretch. PLAYING FOOTSIE was off slowly and showed no speed.
