### Footnotes

QUEENLY LUCK, unhurried along the rail, closed two-wide late turn then rallied outside rivals and got up late under a strong drive. GOLDSTEIN raced midpack, closed between foes late turn, rallied willingly but was outkicked. ALLNIGHTDANCE led early, set a reserved pace along the rail, was all out in the stretch but failed to stay. PECA JONES, in touch along the rail, was all out in the stretch but hung late. CLASSIC SHOES, well back early, saved ground, swung out late turn but did not threaten. GOLD FISH stalked three-wide then tired at the top of the stretch. SAFFI, in touch three-wide, lacked a closing response. RUN FOR FREEDOM stalked the pace, chased on the turn then tired in the stretch. BRAHMS AFFAIR was through early and lacked a rally.
