Footnotes

SAND COVE raced off the pace,closed along the rail late turn, angled two-wide at the top of the stretch, bid midstretch then outfinished DELAFORCE under a drive. DELAFORCE raced off the pace along the second path, angled five-wide leaving the turn, closed quickly and challenged mid stretch, dueled but was outfinished. CAPPAL MOR partnered up with PIPER IN THE GLEN and ROCKGLEN on the backstretch, forced the pace from the rail on the turn, took command and shook clear briefly at the top of the stretch, was quickly engaged and dueled with ROCKGLEN but yielded midstretch and tired. ROCKGLEN pulled to the front three-wide on the backstretch, gained a short lead on the turn, was engaged late turn and headed at the top of the stretch, rebid quickly, dueled to midstretch and tired. EOLOS was unhurried on the backstretch, closed along the rail through the turn, swung six-wide at the top of the stretch but lacked a closing response. PIPER IN THE GLEN, prominent early between horses, was taken back a bit early turn, stayed in contention and chased into the stretch then tired.
