NO APPRECIATION dueled, moved clear into the turn, drew off then held sway under steady encouragement. DOCTOR LUKE raced off the pace, came

four and five-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch and finished gamely. LIL' BREECHES stalked the pace to the stretch then finished all out along the rail. BAD CONNECTION, rated off the pace, was hustled through the turn, chased into the stretch and rallied late outside. MYSTICIAN raced in midpack, was hustled from midturn, chased into the stretch but evened out in the late stages. OSCULATOR raced in midpack, closed four-wide into the stretch, finished all out but was not a threat. DESERT DON JUAN raced in midpack, came four-wide through the turn then lacked a rally. ROMAN EMPIRE raced off the pace, chased into the stretch, finished gamely from the outside but did not menace. BEST IN EGBERT settled off the pace, chased four to six-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. FORESTERS PRIDE, in range, chased three-wide on the turn then evened out in the late stages. DUPPIES, well back early, closed fast outside horses on the turn, came seven-wide into the stretch and evened out. OPUS PRO stalked early, dropped back nearing the turn, was hustled along but lacked a rally. TIME OUT TY dueled, was headed late backstretch, chased, but tired late turn. NO APPRECIATION WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST TO UNPLACED FOR A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
