BUONGIORNO JOHNNY led quickly and moved to the rail, drew off on the turn then held under a drive. TOP PROSPECT settled off the pace, saved ground then finished determinedly. EXECUTIVE FIVE raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide late turn and finished gamely. AWESOME ECLIPSE bumped heads with BIGSTORMBREWIN' at the start, stalked the pace from the rail, chased in the stretch then evened out in late stages. BIGSTORMBREWIN' bumped heads with a rival at the start, stalked the pace, chased late turn then flattened out in the final 16th. MR. CHARTBUSTER raced off the pace, chased five-wide late turn but lacked a closing response. LIGHTHOUSE SOUND settled off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn then lacked a rally.
