Footnotes

DIVINE ROCKETTE was unhurried early along the rail, closed the gap entering the stretch, angled three wide in the final furlong and wore down the leaders under a drive. FLE'CHE ROUGE showed good speed pressing the early pace from the rail, opened a length advantage on the turn, but weakened slightly in the drive and just failed. FAR AND NEAR was away alertly in hand just off the lead outside of rivals and ran evenly. FORUM SEARCH showed good early speed and set the pace in hand, but gave way approaching the far turn and dropped back. AMERICAN SKIPPER was off slowly and void of early speed off the rail, then finished with a mild bid in the stretch, but was never a threat. SILVER CHAMP was void of early speed off the rail and never a factor. DAME A SHOOT was close up outside of rivals, continued off the rail on the turn and faded in the stretch. CARTIER was off slowly and showed no speed. TORRENTIAL FLO was void of early speed and never a factor.
