GIFT OF THE HEART raced midpack, closed two deep late turn, was blocked in the stretch, altered course to the inside, responded smartly and got up late. XTRA DASH advanced gradually three-deep, bid four-wide at the top of the stretch, gained command and drew clear then failed to contain the winner late. PSYCHEDELIA sprinted very sharply to the front right out of the gate, set the pace, was under pressure from rivals on the turn, was engaged at the top of the stretch and yielded then gave up ground stubbornly. ROUGE STONE raced in striking range, closed three-deep late turn and challenged at the top of the stretch but failed to match strides and evened out. MISS MURIEL was well back early, closed two deep late turn, angled out in the stretch but failed to

threaten. STRIKE AND RUN under strong early restraint along the rail, continued to save ground while maintaining position on the turn then hung in the stretch. CHRISTINE'S PRIZE stalked three-wide, bid four-wide at the top of the stretch but flattened out. TENDER YEARS saved ground but lacked the necessary closing response. STARLET APPROVAL stalked the pace from between foes, forced the issue on the turn, challenged at the top of the stretch then tired. ROYAL ATTRACTION stalked the pace from the rail, was up close at the top of the stretch but tired. LITTLE MISS RUCKUS was always far back, raced four-wide and lacked a rally. PEARLS AND JEANS raced three-deep in the middle of the pack and lacked a rally. HIDDEN PARADISE always far back, raced three-deep and lacked a closing response. COUNTRY MEADOW raced in range towards the inside but was through early and tired.
