Footnotes

SAOIRSE vied for the early lead between horses, then dueled outside of SIGNME OR TRADEME through the turn, put that one away in the drive and drew clear under a hand ride. DIMONTINA was hustled along well off the early lead while off the rail, came four wide on the turn and rallied outside of rivals in the drive. SARAREGAL was void of early speed off the rail, angled to the rail and saved ground through the turn, then rallied belatedly inside of rivals. PETE'S FANCY was hustled along inside of rivals while off the rail and ran evenly. CREE PRIDE was void of early speed along the rail, angled out entering the stretch and finished with a mild bid. SIGNME OR TRADEME was hustled along pressing the early pace inside of rivals, then tired in the stretch. DEPUTY HERCULEAN was hustled along outside of rivals and never a threat. DANZIGS SILVER showed brief speed outside of rivals, then dropped back after two furlongs.
