Footnotes

ALWAYS SPLIT ACES vied for the early lead three wide, dueled outside of FLASHY SILVER on the turn, put that one away in the drive and drew clear under steady pressure. FLASHY SILVER set a pressured pace inside of rivals, dueled with the winner on the turn, but weakened in the stretch and just lasted for place. SNOWY WAGER was off slowly and spotted the field two lengths, closed the gap along the rail in the backstretch and settled just off the lead, angled three wide midway on the turn and finished well. RUBY TANGO was void of early speed, roused in the three path and finished with a mild rally. FRIENDLY PIONEER was unhurried early in the three path and lacked a late response. ISAWTHELIGHT showed brief speed between horses, then dropped back approaching the far turn and eased in the drive.
