FOR THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLIES. By subscription of \$125 each which shall accompany the nomination and an additional \$1,250 when making entry. Plus \$50,000 for Ontario Breds from the Thoroughbred Improvement Program and Canadian Thoroughbred Horse Society. The purse to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 three times at a mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; Of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 twice at a mile or over, 5 lbs.; Of a sweepstakes of \$75,000 once at a mile or over, 7 lbs.; Of a sweepstakes of \$60,000 at any distance, 9 lbs.; Of a race other than maiden or claiming, 11 lbs. Final entries to be made through the entry box at the closing time then in effect for overnight events. A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry by a non-refundable fee of \$2,500, which includes the entry fee. Plus up to \$11,040 Ontario Sire/Ontario Bred Breeder Awards. Closed with 38 nominations on Wednesday, August 16, 2006.

Footnotes

ESSENTIAL EDGE raced prominently, dueled on the turn, shook clear at the top of the stretch and widened under light handling. STRIKE SOFTLY stalked

along the rail, was roused upper stretch and finished determinedly. LIKE A GEM stalked along the rail, moved out between horses late turn and was all out in the stretch. A TOUCH OF GLORY raced midpack three-deep, finished gamely in vain. STORM ROYALE raced off the pace along the rail, closed leaving the turn, finished all out but hung late. OUR MADISON raced off the pace between foes, rallied mildly. TOP NOTCH LADY raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn but never reached contention. SUDSY BABY forced the pace three-wide, launched a stretch bid but failed to get up and tired. DANCEROFHEREALM (GB) broke alertly, forced the pace four-wide on the turn, was still close at the top of the stretch but tired. RIVERADA, well back early, angled steadily from the rail to four-wide through the turn but lacked a rally. WEDDED WOMAN loomed five -wide midway of the far turn, chased to the stretch and tired. DEVIL'S BRIDE forced the pace, bid early turn, dueled briefly and tired.
