Footnotes

RUMBLING CLOUD, close on the rail, drove up into tight quarters inside TEMPTING THE WOLF entering the turn and was checked sharply, rallied, bid at the top of the stretch, was headed but dug in and got up late, driving. DISCREET COMMANDER had speed, forced the pace into the turn, bid midturn, shook clear at the top of the stretch but failed to contain the winner. DEPUTY LOR, unhurried early, angled from the rail to three-wide early turn, was hustled four-wide late turn then hung in the stretch. TOBAR stalked from between horses, chased three-wide late turn then hung in the stretch. TEMPTING THE WOLF gained a short lead late backstretch, was engaged midturn but gave way then tired in the stretch. FIGHTING WARRIOR showed speed from between horses, forced the pace into the turn then gave way late turn and tired.
