EMBLA had speed, dueled on the backstretch and turn, drove clear upper stretch and held under steady pressure. BEAUJELAIS NOUVEAU raced midpack, came five-wide and six-wide through the turn then rallied gamely outside. DONERAILE LASS raced midpack, chased hard late turn and was all out through the stretch. SHIVER N SHAKE, rated off the pace, raced two-wide on the turn, chased into the stretch and finished all out. QUEEN OFTHE CASTLE raced off the pace, closed between foes into the turn, was blocked at the top of the stretch then had too little response when clear. PINE LAKE

JAMMER had speed, dueled on the backstretch and turn, yielded upper stretch and tired. GEN'S JO stalked into the turn, chased three-wide into the stretch and tired. LADY JANE, up close early, stalked the duel, chased into the stretch then flattened out. BLACK PEONY raced off the pace, closed five-wide on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but never threatened. HOWEARSTHEPANTS, in range early, raced three-wide on the turn then lacked a rally. SOARING SAPHIRE showed brief speed, settled, then had no response late turn and was through. LADY SELBY, in touch in the early stages, faded five-wide late turn then lacked a rally. COOL CIANO was close early between horses, faded on the backstretch and trailed.
