LEMON VIEW raced off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn, responded smartly and swept to the lead in deep stretch under a drive. SILVER ROCKET showed brief speed then pressed the pace, was bumped at the top of the stretch, bid a furlong out, gained a short lead but was passed in the late stages. PICO PIKE led early, was headed at the turn, chased, was bumped at the top of the stretch, lodged a bid midstretch but was outfinished. HOLY POPPI, in range, was hustled six-wide into the stretch, came in and bumped a rival then finished all out. ESCAPISM raced off the pace, was hustled three to five-wide through the turn then evened out in the late stages. HATCHET pressed the pace, was bumped and squeezed back at the top of the stretch and evened out. ZIP IT NANCE, in touch along the rail, took the lead into the turn, was caught a furlong out and tired.
