SPANISH POST led quickly, was joined and dueled briefly from midway of the backstretch, moved clear on the turn, set the pace then just held under a drive. NIGHT DUTY raced off the pace, was hustled four-wide on the turn, launched an all out charge upper stretch and just missed. NARRATE, off slowly, raced off the pace, chased four-wide on the far turn, rallied, but was outkicked. CLEAR MARCH stalked the pace, was hustled three-wide through the far turn, chased into the stretch then evened out. HARLEM PRINCESS, well back early, angled from the rail to five-wide on the turn, chased, but never reached contention. KATHLEENS A CATCH stalked early, chased three-wide on the far turn then evened out in the stretch. BILL'S THRILL forced the pace, dueled briefly from midway of the backstretch, chased hard through the turn then flattened out in the stretch. PROMISING ROSE broke outward, forced the pace, vied briefly on the backstretch then faded from midturn.
