DOWN WITH DIXIE stalked the pace, took command nearing the far turn, set a pressured pace, was clear into the stretch and held sway under a drive. ARTIE HOT raced off the pace, was hustled angling two to five-wide through the far turn then finished under an all out drive. QUINZEE raced in midpack, chased hard four-wide on the far turn but evened out in deep stretch. STOLONBOY, in range, was hustled on the far turn then rallied late between foes. DINO DINARO raced in midpack, was hustled on the far turn, finished all out but did not menace. POINT TUPPER set a pressured pace from early on the first turn, yielded at the far turn, chased to the stretch then evened out. HANDY HAROLD raced off the pace, was hustled on the far turn, finished all out but never reached contention. DOCTOR JACK showed brief speed then forced the issue from early on the clubhouse turn, chased into the stretch and tired.
