PLENTY O' WOMAN pressed the early pace outside of REDHOTDATE, roused on the turn and assumed command from that one entering the stretch, then drew clear and was under wraps at the wire. PROMISING WEST was allowed to settle off the rail, raced three wide on the turn and got up for place. REDHOTDATE was hustled along setting a pressured pace along the rail, gave way at the quarter pole and just failed for place. SUGAR MISS was void of early speed off the rail and ran evenly. WINGS OF FIRE was hustled along just off the rail, saved ground through the turn, but lacked a strong response in the drive. FLYING TABRIZ was void of early speed off the rail and outrun. STORMY BLISS hit the gate at the start and was turned sideways, recovered and was rushed to contention just off the rail, then tired.
