JUNGLE FIGHTER led early, set a reserved pace then widened through the stretch under very light handling. MORADO raced midpack, was hustled four-wide late turn and finished gamely in vain. J. B.'S VICTORY stalked between horses, closed late turn but finished evenly inside. ARE YOU SERIOUS stalked three-wide, closed late turn, was all out but could not threaten. WILLIE DUNN stalked up close early, was hustled after the leader from midturn but flattened out in the final furlong. LION AROUND, unhurried early, closed along the third path on the turn but never reached contention. SHAMPEL, well back early, saved ground and never threatened. LOVING IT, always well off the pace, raced along the second path then lacked a rally. MINT PROSPECT stalked the pace, was hustled on the turn, was roused late turn but showed no response and was through.
