AT WOODBINE ON WHICH THE MAXIMUM COMMISSION WAS PAID SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE YEARLING SALES STAKES. C.T.H.S. HAS PROVIDED A CERTIFIED LIST OF ELIGIBLE HORSES. SILENT COURSE, always in touch, closed three-deep late turn, swept to the lead midstretch and prevailed, driving. LONDON SNOW closed along the rail leaving the backstretch, bid late turn, moved clear at the top of the stretch but was no match for the winner with a sixteenth to run. SWEET AFTON, well back early, closed four-wide on the turn and finished gamely. SWEET BREANNA, off a step slowly, was hustled along the second path through the turn and rallied gamely. MIGHTY GAYLE trailed early, gained gradually, moved from the rail to four-wide midturn and finished willingly. HOMESTEADER steadied slightly in tight quarters midway of the backstretch, stalked the pace, was hustled four-wide late turn then flattened out. TO THE BRIM stalked from between horses, lacked a closing response. MY GIRL SAM, well back early, raced three-wide on the turn and never threatened. U R FLASHY showed speed under pressure, turned back BELLE OF ASCOT late turn but was no match for LONDON SNOW at the top of the stretch and tired. BAJAN PRINCESS raced midpack, saved ground but lacked a rally. HIGHLAND JEWEL showed speed away from the gate, was hustled along, remained prominent until nearing the turn and faded. BELLE OF ASCOT, prominent from the outset, was headed, bid into the turn, vied briefly and gave way late turn, tired and was eased in the final furlong.
