BEAUSEANT up on the pace, stayed in the game turning for home then angled out in mid stretch, bid outside the leader, took the lead in the late going and just held. SIMPLE SPEED trailed the field, angled out in the stretch to be widest then caught fire in the late going and just missed while outside of foes. HOLD THAT ECHO kept close and stalked the leaders into the turn, bid turning for home, led in the drive only to be outfinished. STARS IN MY EYES had inside speed, vied and then was a factor into mid stretch before giving way. NASIRIYAH'S SONG in mid pack and between foes early, was in the hunt on the turn and in the four path entering the stretch but lacked the needed rally. SILVER PIZZAZZ had an inside trip and failed to menace in the run to the wire. GYPSY SAGE outside of foes turning for home, lacked a stretch response.
