CAPTAIN RAUCOUS settled off the pace, was widest into the stretch, flew home with an outside rally and caught the front runner in the final yards. KIRKLAND LAKE kept in touch, bid three wide on the turn, led in the drive then was outfinished in the final yards. BIG TIME stalked the pace and was in the hunt on the turn, bid from four path and loomed large only to be outkicked to the wire. BLIZZARD BUDDY BEN off the pace, inside and well back, angled off the rail, bid from the four path, angled in, kept coming but it was not enough. MAJOR MARVEL had good speed to lead early, was pressured inside and out on the turn then weakened in the final furlong. BIG BROWN BREWSKI raced well off the pace and showed little. DUBLIN LANE had an early inside bid to vie for the lead into and through the turn then faltered in the run to the wire. NAFTA in striking distance into the turn, failed to rally.
