MUNTASIR tracked while inside, was just off the rail into the stretch, bid and vied with rivals then proved best while full out. NO MOLESTAR was on the pace, bid between in the drive and finished off a solid try. TRAJECTORY'S DREAM kept close throughout while between foes and then was outgunned in the drive. EIRE OF WISDOM just off the pace, bid four wide into the stretch only to be outfinished. JAZ RYDER came from well off the pace to put in a belated wide run. HARD FOUR had an outside trip and a mild wide try. MAJESTIC MONTANA off the pace and in the three path into the stretch, lacked the needed kick. FUNNY PECULIER was off the pace and never a menace. GOLD ACCOUNT saved ground to no avail. SMART DRESSED MAN was far back before passing tired ones. SHAMAL was outside and never a threat. BALLYCANOE faded inside from mid pack. HIGH SPEED had speed to lead the way into the turn then faded when the serious running began.
