ROSE AND SHINE settled in the early going, was outside foes and in striking distance turning for home, then rallied smartly in the late going and proved best. DIXIE STRIKE made up ground and was a factor on the engine and between foes into the stretch, bid from there only to be outkicked. HOLY WINE had speed and then was inside foes on the turn and battling, led in early stretch but failed to last inside of rivals. NOTACLOUDINTHESKY inside in the early going, angled out and was five wide and bidding on the turn only to even out. BEAR'S WIT off the early pace, gained and was between foes on the turn while pressing then evened out in the run to the wire. SAPPHIRE STAR had an inside trip and was in touch behind a wall of rivals on the turn then lacked the needed finish. I'VEATIGERINMYTANK made up ground then bid and was in a tussle between foes on the turn but had nothing to give in the stretch run. ON WE GO was in the hunt briefly then backed off and never threatened in the drive. THEATRE QUEEN close early, was in the hunt on the turn while between foes then all done for the drive. FAMILY RESERVE led in the early going, gave way on the turn then faded.
