Footnotes

COOKING SCHOOL, in range, closed late turn, bid in the final furlong, drew clear and was well in hand at the finish. LA REINE DE MOTS, off alertly, was joined in a duel, moved clear early turn and drew off, drifted out five-wide late turn, was caught in the final furlong and yielded grudgingly. MISS LAYLA raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn, came six-wide to the top of the stretch then evened out in the late stages. ROCKABYEBABY forced the pace, was taken back when SHESACUTIE MOVED UP TO DUEL, stalked THE PACE, chased into the stretch but evened out. HIGHLAND FLARE raced off the pace, came three to five-wide through the turn and never reached contention. CAP THAT, off slowly, was under a patient ride, was roused late turn but failed to show a serious response. SHESACUTIE, off slowly, was hustled hard to the fore, dueled, could not keep up on the turn, faded approaching the stretch and tired.
