### Footnotes

CONTANGO forced the pace then was sent to the lead approaching the turn, drew away and widened under a steady drive. MONTY'S BEST, well back early, angled from the rail to three-wide late turn and rallied to be best of the rest while unable to menace. COFFEE BAR, in range between horses, was checked behind rivals late turn, moved to the rail at the top of the stretch then evened out. CLASSIC DAY, in range, closed along the fourth path late turn but evened out in the final furlong. BALAMORY raced off the pace, saved ground then had only a mild late response. ADDED FORCE broke alertly and led briefly, was headed late on the backstretch, chased from the rail early turn,angled three-wide late turn then tired in the final furlong. TROUBLE TODAY stalked the pace close up, closed three-wide into the turn, chased to the top of the stretch and tired.
