DON'S FOLLY raced off the pace, was hustled hard angling from three to five-wide on the turn then finished under an all out drive and was up in time. DRUNKEN LOVE led early, set a reserved pace but gave way in deep stretch. FLASHY YANKEE closed late backstretch to gain striking position, chased on the turn and was all out through the stretch. RACE FOR GOLD, rated early, was hustled along the rail on the turn but evened out in midstretch. DOCTOR JACK raced off the pace, closed four-wide late turn but never reached contention. DO YOU BELIEVE IT stalked the pace, chased three then four-wide on the turn but tired a furlong out. AMERICAN SCOUT, rated early, was roused late turn then lacked a response in the stretch.
