QUEST MASTER was shuffled back at the start and allowed to settle off the rail, stayed outside in the stretch and wore down rivals to get up in the final strides. RUSHISCOMINGUP stalked the pace, drew even in the three path around the turn, dueled into the turn and into the stretch but was outfinished at the wire. ANGEL'S TEARLET stalked the pace, saved ground around the turn and slipped through at the 1/4 pole, dueled gamely in the stretch, but weakened at the end. ALL FIRMED UP was void of early speed, had no rally and was never a threat. PERLONG was away alertly, set the pace into the first turn, dueled in the turn before tiring in the stretch.
