



**Footnotes**

ONE AND TWENTY was in hand inside of rivals, closed the gap between horses approaching the far turn, blocked briefly entering the stretch, but angled outside of SWIFT OF FLIGHT in the drive and assumed command in the final furlong and edged clear under strong urging. SWIFT OF FLIGHT sped to the early lead and moved to the rail in the early going, opened a clear advantage in the backstretch and stayed in front to deep stretch before giving way. SAND SPRINGS was allowed to settle just off the rail, closed the gap three wide at the three eighths pole, but weakened in the late going. LITTLE MISS PAMELA was unhurried early outside of rivals, closed the gap four wide on the turn, but flattened out in the drive. LOST ROMANCE was unhurried early outside of rivals, roused between horses on the turn and finished with a late rally four wide. QUEEN OF QUEENS was void of early speed, swung wide on the turn and found her best stride in the late going. BUFFALO JUMP saved ground in the early going, angled out in upper stretch and made a mild bid, but was never a threat. FRITZZY HOUR was unhurried early, roused on the turn, but never rallied and was never a factor. MEGHANMEHAPPY raced close up between horses, then dropped back in the stretch. BETTER HALF chased the early leader from the inside, then tired on the turn and dropped back.
