LOVELY LO led quickly, set a reserved pace, quickened late turn and widened then held sway under a hand ride. NO IT ISN'T stalked from midpack early, chased three and four-wide on the turn then finished determinedly. LADY GEEGEE raced off the pace, was hustled along the rail through the turn but evened out in the stretch. U GET THE PICTURE raced off the pace, chased late turn but never reached contention. LION'S GHOST bobbled slightly leaving, stalked the pace in hand, chased on the turn then evened out in the stretch. STELLAR KISSES settled well off the pace, was hustled angling from the rail to four-wide through the turn then flattened out in the stretch. CHAMPAGNE DYNASTY, away slowly, raced off the pace, was hustled three to five-wide on the turn but lacked a rally.
