STORMY ALLURE sprinted clear quickly and set the pace, drew off upper stretch and held sway under a strong hand ride. HENNY BLUES stalked the pace, chased five-wide into the stretch, was determined and was just up for the place. YANKEE CANDY, used early, forced the pace on the backstretch, chased hard on the turn but evened out in deep stretch. WAITING FOR TIME settled off the pace, saved ground then was hustled along the rail through the stretch. PHOENIX COURT raced off the pace, was hustled four to six-wide on the turn but never reached contention. DIXIE BELLE raced in midpack, came three to five-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch then tired in the final furlong. HEROIC CHARM settled well back early, saved ground but never reached contention. YAWENS REVENGE chased from the rail, dropped back a little on the turn, continued to chase but tired in the final furlong. RETURN ENGAGEMENT raced in midpack, was roused three-wide late turn then tired in the stretch.
