Footnotes

ASCANIA forced the pace, was roused four-wide late turn, bid midstretch and drove clear. PROFIT PREFERRED forced the pace, bid midway of the far turn, dueled, led into the stretch, was headed a 16th out but finished gamely. QUEENSBURY RULES stalked the pace, chased on the far turn, launched his bid a furlong out, was passed but finished determinedly. CELESTIAL FIRE broke outward, raced in midpack, chased three and four-wide on the far turn and finished gamely. LAWYER JIM, rated off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. GIOLITTI set a pressured pace, was headed late turn, chased into the stretch and evened out. LANGFUHR GLORY raced in midpack, was hustled four-wide on the turn but failed to menace. SLEW THE MAESTRO settled off the pace, was hustled along the rail through the far turn then flattened out in the stretch. ROYAL COLWOOD settled in midpack in hand, closed two and three-wide on the turn but lacked a closing response. TWINKLE OF HOPE broke inward, settled off the pace then lacked a closing response.
