GINGER GOLD was well rated inside of GLOBAL VISION in the early going, taken back approaching the far turn and moved to the outside of that one, assumed command entering the stretch and drew clear under intermittent urging. WEST MADISYN was allowed to settle inside of rivals, closed the gap on the turn and dueled between horses for place, battled gamely to the wire and prevailed for that position. SOUTHEY was void of early speed, roused three wide on the turn and dueled three wide for place weakening slightly in the late going. GLOBAL VISION sped to the early lead in hand and drew clear approaching the far turn, but weakened in the drive. BLAZING FLAG was allowed to settle in the two path and lacked a late response. RECHE DIAMANT was unhurried early inside of rivals and never rallied. SUAVE DARLING was away alertly and showed brief speed outside of rivals, then dropped back on the turn.
