REALLY SHARP, off alertly, pressed the pace, bid three-wide late turn, dueled, drove clear in the final furlong then held DETERT STRIKE safe under steady pressure. DESERT STRIKE raced off the pace, chased four-wide on the turn, rallied gamely and just missed. BLUEGRASS PRIDE set a pressured pace, dueled on the turn then gave way in the final furlong. NATIVE GOLD forced the issue, dueled on the turn then gave way in the final furlong. TRADE RUMOR, off slowly, raced well back, was hustled three-wide on the turn then tendered a mild late rally. ON COMMAND stalked the pace, chased three-wide on the turn then tired in the stretch. MIZZEN THE ACTION settled off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide on the turn but never reached contention. LOWER EASTSIDE raced in midpack, chased along the rail on the turn then tired in the stretch.
