Footnotes

EL SOPRANO was unhurried early along the rail, checked hard entering the far turn and dropped back, swung to the outside at the three eighths pole and was full of run well off the rail getting up in the final strides. MIESQUE'S APPROVAL stalked the early pace between horses, closed the gap in upper stretch and bumped repeatedly with DEELITEFUL GUY battling for a gap between horses, won that battle and closed fast inside of rivals just missing. NORTH BROOKLYN was unhurried early outside of rivals, rallied four wide entering the stretch and assumed command with a furlong to go, continued strong to the wire, but was outfinished. NATIVE MARK was unhurried between horses, checked approaching the far turn, roused three wide in the drive and finished with a mild rally. CLASSIC RUNAWAY broke sharply and vied for the early lead three wide, then weakened in the stretch. DEELITEFUL GUY was allowed to settle in the early going, moved to the rail on the turn, closed the gap in upper stretch, but was bumped repeatedly and checked in mid stretch dropping back after that. WILD SUNSET saved ground in the early going and was checked on the far turn, saved ground into the stretch and was never a threat. UNION PLACE pressed the early pace outside of rivals, then weakened between horses in the drive. OPEN CONCERT was shuffled back at the start and settled along the rail in the early going, then weakened in deep stretch and dropped back. ADJALAH broke very slowly and was unhurried early, roused on the turn and made a mild bid, but weakened in the drive and was never a factor. Following the race there was a Stewards' inquiry for possible interference in the run through the stretch involving UNION PLACE, DEELITEFUL GUY and MIESQUE'S APPROVAL. After reviewing the tapes, the Stewards ruled there were no infractions and the order of finish remained unchanged.
