Footnotes

WHY NOT GOLD stalked the pace from between rivals, responded to urging upper stretch, was under a strong drive and just got up. KEMPADOO raced off the pace, closed into the turn, challenged five-wide late turn, dueled into the stretch, wore down his rival but failed to contain the winner at the wire. CHARMING COUNTRY raced midpack, was steadied behind tiring rivals just past midturn then was blocked but patient late turn, split foes at the top of the stretch and rallied smartly inside. CHRISCODEY had early speed but dropped back to stalk the duel midway of the backstretch, rebid early turn, dueled gamely then gave way grudgingly in the late stages. EAST SIDE JOHNNY, well back early, closed five-wide late turn, showed a mild rally then evened out late. PAYNES GOLD, well back early, closed six-wide late turn, was determined in the stretch but hung late. JAZZ BOY raced off the pace, was hustled two then three-wide on the turn, was game in the stretch but hung late. MYSTAMY raced midpack, closed into the turn, was contentious while four-wide but tired a furlong out. DEPUTY LOR, well back early, angled from the rail to four-wide closing late turn then evened out in the stretch. WAR DRUMMER was prominent early, dueled to early turn and tired. ONEWAY LOVE AFFAIR dropped well off the early pace, raced well back throughout and lacked a rally. COBRA CLASSIC raced forwardly from the outset, dueled to the top of the stretch and tired. DIAMOND TREE raced forwardly, dueled to the top of the stretch and tired. OGYGIAN'S STORM was close on the backstretch but was through by the turn, faded, then was eased in the stretch.
