DEVI DEVILLE vied for the lead 3 wide, had a clear lead at the 1/2 pole, held the advantage in the stretch under an all out drive. ITS DUECES WILD stalked the pace from the inside, angled out around the 2nd turn but could not close any ground on the leader in the stretch. MALICIA SONG was unhurried early, made a quick move 3 wide around the 2nd turn, moved to the rail in upper stretch but hung. SIP'N TIME was void of early speed, roused 4 wide around the 2nd turn but was never a threat. LAVERLOCHERE was allowed to settle 3 wide, dropped back around the 2nd turn, dull effort. AMERICIUM had a slight advantage into the first turn from inside, tired after a half and dropped back, returned lame and was vanned off. QUIET SOLACE pressed the pace between horses to the 1/2 pole, dropped back around the 2nd turn.
