HONEY GREEN stalked the pace from off the rail, gained command in upper stretch, and drew off. OLYMPIC ADVICE well placed four wide, was off the rail on the turn, rallied four wide for the place position. TEEWEE'S HOPE trailed while off the rail, rallied mildly four wide. LUCKY DAZZLER had a short lead early, stalked the pace three wide, and was not a threat. BITTERSWEET RAIN had speed to clear while racing well out in the middle of the course, moved inside on the turn, gave way in upper stretch. QUEEN OF QUEENS raced off the rail, and showed little.
