BRASS IN POCKET led quickly, moved to the rail and set a reserved pace then held sway under a hand ride. WINTER GARDEN broke in the air then remained unhurried, launched her rally four-wide from midturn, drifted out at the top of the stretch then finished willingly, but late. EL PRADO ESSENCE was always in range, raced along the second path and finished gamely to no avail. LA TRILLIUM stalked the pace, closed along the third path from midturn then flattened out in the stretch. SPANISH DECREE closed along the rail late backstretch, stalked through the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but flattened out in the final furlong. ALPHA HEAT was hustled along the rail through the turn then lacked a rally. MILLE FEVILLE stalked the pace three-wide then tired at the top of the stretch.
